



## School Curriculum Plan: Summer Term 2021

### Year 1 – Mrs Dryden

<p><b>English</b> We will start by looking at nature poems, including Daffodils by William Wordsworth. We will read the Snail and the Whale by Julia Donaldson and write our own sequel to the story. After half term, we will be looking at other poems, information texts and letters. We will continue to work on our writing, trying to use neat, correctly formed letters in all our work not just our handwriting sessions. We will work on punctuating sentences correctly and spelling some of the tricky words that we have learned in phonics.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b> We will continue to work on extending our number and place value up to 50 and later to 100. We will be looking at multiplication and division, using multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will cover fractions, recognising that the parts have to be equal. We will be looking at position and direction and the language associated with it. We will look at time, including telling the time to the hour and half past, days of the week and months of the year. We will learn about money and practice recognising the different coins.</p>
<p><b>Phonics</b> In phonics we will be working on the children’s sound and whole word recognition, word building and spelling skills using phonics and spelling activities appropriate to their ability.</p>	<p><b>R.E.</b> In term 5, the children will be discussing the Big Question ‘Does Creation help people understand God?’ We will look at the Creation story and how we should care for our World. In term 6 we will look at the question ‘Do we need shared special places?’ when we will focus on looking at a synagogue and identifying the key features. We will compare this to other special places.</p>
<p><b>Topic</b> Our topic this term is the great outdoors. We will learn about features in the environment, both natural and man-made. We will be looking at maps, the symbols used on maps and directions. We will draw our own maps of the school and our journey to school. We will include work on weather and the seasons.</p>	<p><b>Science</b> In term 5 we will be identifying materials. The children will be identifying and naming common types of materials and grouping objects made from the same material. In term 6 we will be looking at plants. The children will learn about the way plants grow and change over time and look at the similarities and differences between different plants.</p>
<p><b>Art</b> We will be basing our art on our topic of the great outdoors. Our work will include observational drawing and looking at the work of Andy Goldsworthy. We will also look at trees in summer as part of our work on the seasons.</p>	<p><b>Computing</b> This term the children will continue to develop their programming skills using the Hour of Code programming environment and work on using repeat loops. The children will then work on their keyboard skills and practice typing sentences.</p>
<p><b>D.T.</b> Following our topic, we will be designing and making a model playground.</p>	<p><b>Music</b> The children will be listening to different songs that inspire imagination and thinking about these songs. They will explore sounds and learn about the pitch and the beat of a piece of music.</p>
<p><b>P.E.</b> This term will include skipping, athletics and outdoor games. The children will learn about warming up and cooling down. They will be developing basic game playing skills, including following instructions. Our PE lessons are on Tuesday and Friday, but it is useful to have PE kits in school all week.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b> Our topic this term will be ‘Being my best’, including keeping healthy and being positive. In term 6, our topic will be ‘Growing and Changing’. Towards the end of the year, we will think about moving on to a new class.</p>
